- i. associated with electric discharge lighting systems;
- ii. associated with X-ray equipment;
- iii. associated with high frequency equipment;
- iv. within self contained equipment supplied at low voltage; or
- v. associated with electric fences intended primarily for the control or containment of animals.

Required attachments:

- details of on-the-job training with a current Class V Inspector, including at least 10, examples of high voltage electrical inspections. Please include relevant copies of the prescribed Certificate of Electrical Safety,
- a supporting reference from the Class V Inspector who provided the training and is willing to attest to your competency,
- any other training or qualification evidence relevant to high voltage that you hold.

M Class

Description:

Electrical wiring and associated fixed electrical equipment installed in body-protected or cardiac-protected electrical areas of hospitals, and other medical and dental practices.

Required attachments:

- evidence of on-the-job training with a current Class M Inspector, including at least 10 examples of patient area medical/electrical inspections.
- Please include copies of prescribed Certificates of Electrical Safety. The 10 examples should include at least six inspections of cardiac-protected electrical areas and four of body-protected electrical areas,
- a supporting reference from the Class M Inspector who provided the training and is willing to attest to your competency

Privacy Statement – How we use and disclose your personal information

- responding to complaints about electrical installation work
- providing Certificates of Electrical Safety information to your customers and the owners or occupiers of premises to which the certificates relate
- providing Certificate of Electrical Safety information to our external auditors who may carry out safety audits of the work described in the certificate
- providing information to other government agencies, including emergency services, law enforcement and security agencies, including Victoria Police if the information is reasonably required by that agency to carry out an investigative, law enforcement or regulatory function
- disclosing your licence or registration status to employers, prospective employers or members of the public who wish to check this status
- to maintain any public registers required by our regulations
- for communications purposes and to provide you with relevant updates and general information about Energy Safe's activities and safety alerts
- prosecution or disciplinary action when we suspect that fraud or unlawful activity has been, is being or may be engaged in; and
- any other purposes required or authorised by law
- we may also disclose your personal information to our contracted service providers that help deliver our services (which may include organisations that provide archival, auditing, professional advisory, banking, mail house, delivery, call centre, information technology, research, utility and security services). We may also disclose your personal information to your authorised representatives or third parties acting on your behalf (for example, your solicitor or interpreter)
- you can request access to the personal information we hold about you at any time. We will try to give you access with as little formality as possible and without charging a fee. However, where your request is difficult or time consuming to answer, or where it involves personal information about other people, we may have to use freedom of information procedures to process the request
